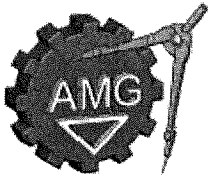

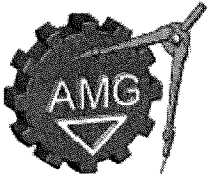

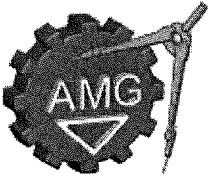
Ability to perform basic mathematical computations.
